Print these ock words.





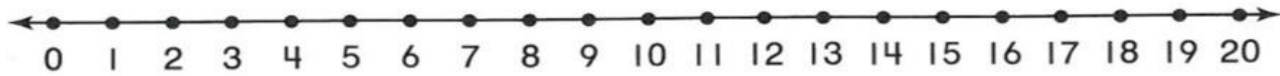
